



Licensed Teacher Renewal/Reinstatement Policy (January 1997)

When a Licensed Teacher who has been inactive, either by request or by inactivity, wants to be reinstated to active status, s/he must:

- actively attend church services and functions for a minimum of six months
- be involved in a volunteer capacity as designed by the minister. This may include teaching non-credit classes, but the minister has the freedom to require service in whatever capacity would be most valuable to the ministry and the individual seeking reactivation.
- have post graduate credits up to date
- be recommended in writing for reactivation by the senior minister of the church in which s/he has participated
- submit a written request for reactivation

Provided all criteria have been met, the request will be submitted for consideration to the Executive Committee, which will make the final determination. NOTE: The above criterion does not prohibit more stringent requirements under special circumstances.
